PBC STATEMENT OF FAITH

This church receives the Scriptures as the verbal and plenary inspired Word of God, and as the sole authority in matters of faith and practice. Its understanding of Christian truth as therein contained is expressed by the following Declaration of Faith:

- 1. We believe that the Bible is God's inspired Word; that it was written by men divinely inspired by the Holy Spirit; and that it is the inerrant and supreme authority in all matters of faith and conduct.
- 2. We believe that there is one God, eternally existent in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
- 3. We believe in God the Father, perfect in holiness, infinite in wisdom, measureless in power. We rejoice that He concerns Himself mercifully in the affairs of men, that He hears and answers prayer, and that He saves from sin and death all who come to Him through Jesus Christ.
- 4. We believe in Jesus Christ, the eternal and only begotten Son of God, conceived by the Holy Spirit, of virgin birth, sinless in His life; making full atonement for the sins of the world by His death through His shed blood. We believe in His bodily resurrection, His ascension, pretribulation rapture of the church, and visible pre-millennial return to the world according to His promise.
- 5. We believe in the Holy Spirit who came forth from God to convince the world of sin, of righteousness, and of judgment, and to regenerate, sanctify and comfort those who believe in Jesus Christ.
- 6. We believe that all men by nature and by choice are sinners, but that "God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life." We believe, therefore, that those who personally receive Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior will rejoice forever in God's presence and those who refuse to accept Christ as Lord and Savior will be forever separated from God.
- 7. We believe in the Church A living, spiritual body of which Christ is the Head, and of which all regenerated people are members. We believe that a visible church is a company of believers in Jesus Christ, immersed on a credible confession of faith and associated for worship, work and fellowship. We believe that to these visible churches were committed, for perpetual observance, the ordinances of Baptism and the Lord's Supper, and that God has laid upon these churches the task of urging a lost world to personally receive Jesus Christ as Savior, and to enthrone Him as Lord and Master. We believe that all human betterment and social improvements are the inevitable byproducts of such a gospel.

<u>Application Procedure</u>

- 1. Application is made by filling out and returning an application form (from website).
- 2. Housing requests are accepted by the Trustee Board and given to missionaries with housing needs of 1 month or more.

Security Deposits:

All accepted applications are tentative and contingent upon receipt of a \$250 Security Deposit. Once the application is accepted and the \$250 Security Deposit is received, the reservation is considered confirmed. The Deposit is refundable in case of cancellation, and the deposit will be held until after your departure to provide funding for any outstanding expenses. These may include damage to residences considered more than normal wear and tear and cleaning charges when the residence has not been properly cleaned prior to departure. After the deduction of any such charges, the excess will be refunded.

Billing and Payments:

We want your stay to be both fruitful and restful so we try to keep the home in good to excellent condition. Please let us know of any maintenance needed in the home. Most maintenance we can accomplish fairly quickly, some we will need to put on our project list.

- 1. The first month's payment is the Security Deposit which must be paid to secure the reservation (See "Security Deposits").
- 2. All subsequent month's rent of \$200.00 is due on the first working day of each month.

Other General Policies:

- 1. PBC requires its guests to take care of the cleaning of the home in all aspects, along with the linens used, prior to departure. We will give residents a housekeeping checklist upon arrival for information about cleaning that is necessary before departure.
- 2. PBC allows NO ALCOHOL, SMOKING, or ILLICIT DRUGS in the home or on campus. There is also a NO PETS policy in the home or on the campus. If you have a pet, please make arrangements for the pet's care prior to arriving at PBC.
- 3. Notify office of approximate arrival time and if a delay is expected. If you need other arrangements, please let the office know as soon as possible.
- 4. PBC reserves the right to terminate this agreement following a discussion with the Chairman of Trustees
- *Exception to this policy will be rare and only after careful review of the circumstances described in writing to the **Chairman of Trustees**.
